Kingdom of God

In the New Testament we find Jesus the Christ, the Son of the Living God, preaching about the Kingdom of God. We find this even in the parables he illustrated and what the Kingdom of God would be like. Not many Pastors and Teachers today are explaining or even alluding to the Kingdom of God, and his righteousness.

There is a literal Kingdom to be set up when Christ returns to earth. However, in this dispensation, we are Ambassadors and witnesses of that Kingdom. Christ said the Kingdom of God was not of this world, or this present time! We are to be an illustration of that government in our daily lives. Christ said "the Kingdom of God is within you." Later we will be leaders as kings and priests when Christ comes back to earth.

What does it mean to be an ambassador? It is an official representative of an organization or movement.

Christ has given us the authority to represent his Kingdom, now, in this life! Seeing this is the case, on what should we focus? We must be guided by the King of kings, and Lord of lords. And so our wholehearted attention must be on Christ and not on this world's system. Our allegiance must be to that government first and foremost. "Seek you first the Kingdom of God, and all these things will be added unto you."

Of course this does not mean we are disloyal to our government. We are commanded to pray for our government and its leaders on the national, state, and local level. We are to pray for leaders of nations in the world. We should be praying for Egypt, Libya, and all the nations in danger in the Middle East. We must pray for the peace of Jerusalem!

When the Kingdom of God comes to this earth at the return of Christ, the world will learn and be taught principles of economy, health, agriculture, family life, and equality for all peoples! Allegiance to the government of God will become the popular thing! The people will say, "Come let us go up unto the house of the Lord in Jerusalem so that we can learn of his ways!" the trip to Jerusalem will be greater than all resort areas in this world combined! For it is not just for physical pleasure, but for spiritual renewal and recharging of spiritual batteries. Micah 4: 1-4 NLT

In the last days the Temple of the Lord in Jerusalem will become the most important place on earth. People from all over the world will go there to worship. Many nations will come and say, "Come let us go to the mountain of the Lord, to the Temple of the God of
