Pitfalls of a Christian

There are many pitfalls to the teachings in the “Christian community” today. Mixing law with grace is a gospel that is no gospel at all. Do not fall for these untruths. They are designed to trip the true believer and it will lead to confusion, as it did in the early church. It is a “falling away” from grace into error, and taking the believer away from Christ.

Christ was the end of the law. His perfect sacrifice ended the works of the law. The Old Covenant was, since that day until now, obsolete. That is why Christ came to fulfill the law. No human, no matter how hard he tried, could ever keep the law, so Christ did it for us.

There is no command in the word of God to get back to our Jewish roots. Paul spent a lot of time explaining to the Jews and Gentiles that the laws of God were now on their hearts, written by the finger of the Holy Spirit, Jesus Christ, and God the Father. Read the book of Galatians, and learn this gospel first hand, from the pure, unadulterated word of the living God. Returning and looking back is forbidden, for Christ said, “No man, after putting his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.” (Luke 9:62)

Do not consult with a Rabbi, as to how you are to conduct yourself in the kingdom. It is trying to mix oil and water, it will not “blend” Let the word of God be your teacher and not someone who is not led by the Holy Spirit. Amen and amen
